About us

1) Sanstha:

Ahmednagar Jilha Maratha Vidya Prasarak Samaj' is one of the oldest & pioneering society / trust which has been promoting education since 1918. The Late Chhatrapati Shahu Maharaj of Kolhapur not only inspired but also financially supported the starting of the society. The progress started with the establishment Late Hutatma Karveer Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Maratha Boarding in 1918. The Residential High School (earlier named as Tagore High School) was established in 1941. From this period onwards development started at a faster pace.

The main focus of the society / trust has been to provide education to the economically backward community and for the famine stricken and hilly regions. It has established a network of 89 educational units. This includes 12 Higher & Technical colleges, 25 Higher Secondary Schools, 48 Secondary Schools and 4 Primary & Ashram Schools throughout the Ahmednagar district that impart education in various fields like Arts, Commerce, Science, Education, Law, Engineering, Management, Computer Science & Hotel Management.



2) College :

Shri Dhokeshwar College was established in 1994 on unaided basis with single faculty of Arts. The very modest objective of founders behind establishing this college in Draught-Prone Area like Takali Dhokeshwar village & its vicinity was to promote education among the deprived classes & especially the girl students, lacking opportunity at a convenient place.

It received permanent affiliation in 2004 from University of Pune now called as Savitribai Phule Pune University. After completing seven years of its existence & by giving out excellent results in the University Examination, Govt. of Maharashtra was pleased to extend 100% grant since Academic Year 2000-2001. College went through NAAC accreditation process in 2003. As result of it at its successive stages new faculties, courses were initiated like Science Faculty in 2008, Travel & Tourism in 2010, and Commerce Faculty in 2013. The college came to be recognized under 2 F & 12 B by University Grant Commission since 2006. But, due to change in the name of college it got a new recognition on 14/04/2014. Meanwhile women's hostel was built with support of UGC grants.

The college strives to develop all round personality of students and hence is very keen to provide coaching in curricular, co-curricular, extra-curricular activities. Overall development of the students is the main objective of our institution. To be very modest, it won't be out of place to say that we have succeeded in achieving this goal to a certain extent.

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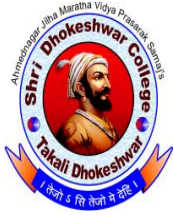

Financial Planning Programme

Commerce department organized Lecture by Professor Dr. Dilip Bhangade Dnyansadhana College, Thane, on dated 05 august 2016. He guided the students on what is stock market, how to open their own D-mat account while investing in stock market, what precautions should be taken, what are the different ways of investment, how the small savings of a person gets big form and he explained to the students through example that it works for the country. He asserted that according to the phrase "Take care of the pennies and the pounds will take care of themselves", citizens need to save and the savings should be invested properly. Also, while looking at different ways of investment, it is necessary for a common person to invest by considering all the aspects that which way will give the highest return and how the risk will remain minimum. Before investing, it is necessary to decide the investment plan. While making an investment plan, it is necessary to take an investment decision by considering all the aspects of how much money we are going to invest and what should be duration of it . What kind of profit can be made and how much loss can be incurred along with it, whether we can bear that loss. He said that while investing, the investor should consider his own age, income, risk capacity and investment period.

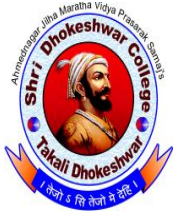

A two-days District Level workshop on Consumer Protection Act and Remedial Scheme was organized under the Department of Commerce in the college on 6th and 7th march 2017. On the occasion of this programme Professor, Dr. M.V. Gite, Vice Principal and HOD Department of Commerce, New Arts, Commerce and Science College, Ahmednagar and Hon'ble Mr. Shahu Auti, Member, Consumer Protection Forum provided valuable guidance to the students. Hon'ble Mr. Shahu Auti, Member, Consumer Protection Forum explained to the students the Consumer Protection Act 1986 and the three tiered consumer protection mechanism under it. The students were guided about how to file a complaint, in how many days and to which forum; up to what amount can they file a complaint in case of fraud. 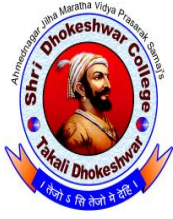

To bring financial and banking service facilities to the working class of all general and all strata of people.

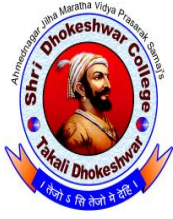
Through his lecture, he convinced the students that financial literacy is important for knowing about various financial service facilities i.e. in all financial transactions.

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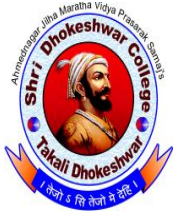
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Department of Commerce Programme Third Commerce Festival

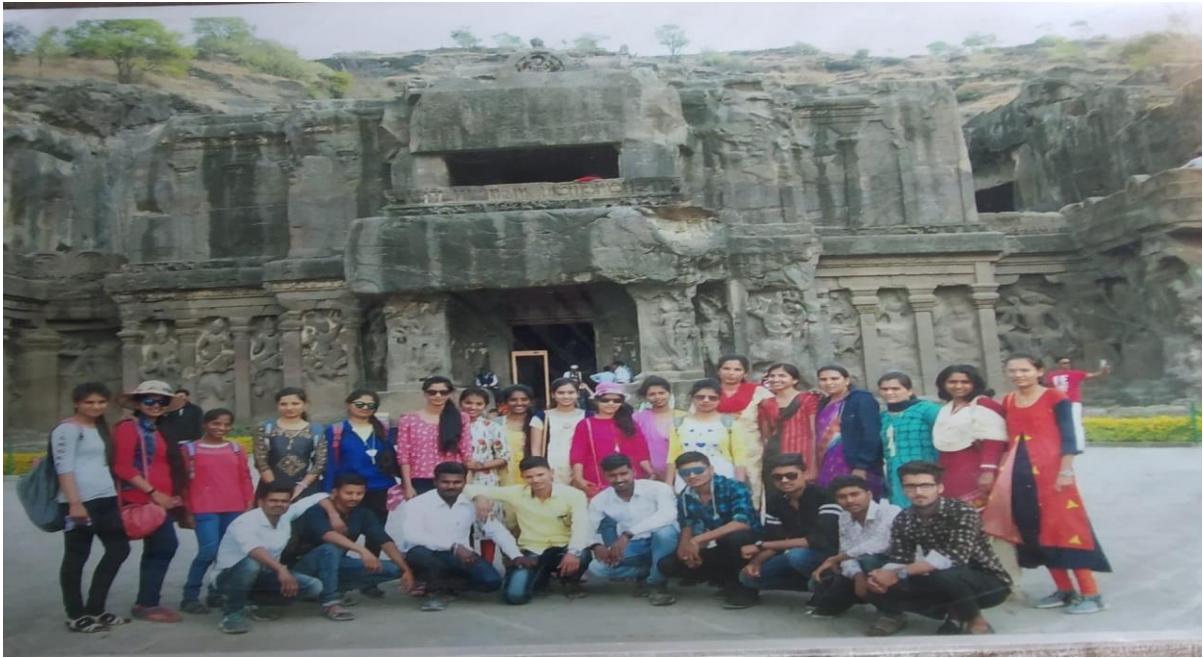
Programme Fourth

In this trip, the students visited Mahabaleshwar. They saw various points there and enjoyed the strawberry, roasted corn and various dishes there and then visited Pratapgarh. Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj built Pratapgad in 1656 AD. This fort is a witness of Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj's bravery and prowess. A battle was fought between Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj and Afzal Khan at this fort.

On 17th January, we went to visit to Srivardhan and Harihareshwar where river Savitri meets the sea at Harihareshwar. Harihareshwar beach is clean. On January 25, 2020, Hon'ble Satish Lanke, Assistant Sales Tax Commissioner, Pune, delivered a lecture on Goods and Services Tax Implications. In this he explained why there was a need to implement GST. The biggest feature of GST tax is that it will be uniform across the country on any item i.e. consumers in any part of the country will have to pay the same tax on that item. He explained the four types of GST to the students including CGST, GST, UTGST, and IGST. He also gave information about the rate at which GST is levied on which items. He also guided the students on how to register GST, how to pay GST. He also explained to the students that GST has been implemented in India from July 2017 and what is the penal provision for non-payment of GST. Due to GST, tax evasion will be curbed after implementation of this tax system, central and state governments will get equal share of this tax. Goods and Services Tax is a tax imposed at producer, trader, consumer, general level. He mentioned that the GST tax system was implemented in India as the Indian economy needed a single tax system by removing all the complicated taxes that were the net of indirect taxes in India.
