#### 1) Students Feedback on curriculum:




Figure 1: Students Feedback on Curriculum




Figure 2: Students Feedback on Curriculum




Figure 3:Students Feedback on Teachers




Figure 4: Students Feedback on Teachers




Figure 5:Teacher Feedback on Curriculum




Figure 6: Teacher Feedback on Curriculum




Figure 7:Parents feedback on the syllabus




Figure 8: Parents' feedback on the syllabus




Figure 9:Alumnis feedback on current syllabus




Figure 10:Alumnni's feedback on current syllabus




Figure 11: Feedback from Employer




Figure 12: Feedback from Employer




Figure 13:Overall feedback analysis as per scale




Figure 14: Overall feedback analysis (on an average)
